

Makor Chaim continues to pioneer outreach programs throughout the world which are predicated on the fact that Jewish Unity and Jewish spirituality are inseparable. While the three boys are no longer with us, we continue to empower their legacy.

We want to educate new generations along their path, but in order to do so, we need you as our partner.

We turn to the entire Jewish nation, to all of its sectors, to stand together with us and take part in the construction of a new campus in their memory, a place where their legacy can grow and prosper.



While Makor Chaim was not known outside of Israel until the tragic kidnapping and murder of our students in the summer of 2014, in Israel, Makor Chaim has long been widely recognized as one of Israel's foremost, cutting-edge innovative educational powerhouses.

In 1984, at the young age of 27, Rabbi Dov Singer was asked by Rabbi Adin Steinsaltz to establish and lead the Yeshiva. Their unique collaboration has resulted in the rare synthesis of high level intellectual pursuit together with the warmth and joy of "Chassidut Eretz Yisrael". Students are empowered to develop their inner spiritual consciousness in a way that is open and integrative with the outside world, inculcating graduates with a strong sense of individuality coupled with commitment to their communities, land and people.

The eclectic staff and student body come from widely varying sectors within the traditional community.

Alumni go on to integrate into combat units in the Israeli military as well as to establishing a Torah presence in new communities in Israel Wherever they go, it is with the mindset of bridging between all facets of Jewish peoplehood. It is from such a place, that the



cohesiveness briefly witnessed in the summer of 2014, which had been missing for so many years, could spring forth...

In addition to our well known, pioneering Yeshiva High School now serving 320 students, Rabbi Singer's leadership has led to the establishment of the "Beit Midrash L'Hitchadshut" – a nationwide, Neo-Chassidic "Personal Spiritual Self-Renewal" study & prayer outreach program for adults which appeals to Israelis from all levels of personal observance. Other educational programs include "Lifnei V'Lifnim" – a creative, alternate educators' training program, which emphasizes the development of emotional intelligence as well as refining sensitivity and creativity.

Our success has spread overseas, with the addition of unique international student exchange programs with New York's Yeshiva University High School – MTA and South Africa's Yeshiva College.

Makor Chaim's unique contribution to the education system and to Israeli society in general is showing the way the text speaks to each of us personally in a different fashion and the way we weave Torah scholarship from an individual and existential study into a basket of professional training and coaching tools.



The Urgent Need for a New Campus


Makor Chaim's 320 high school students as well as those who take part in the public adult education programs have been operating out of the very same "temporary" shacks which housed Yeshivat Har Etzion over 45 years ago. Needing to expand, Kibbutz Kfar Etzion has insisted that an alternate site be found for the school.

In addition, staying on would be prohibitive due to the high cost of rent, energy wasted by leaking, un-insulated structures, the high price of maintenance, roofs which collapse in the snow and the lack of room to expand.

There is no alternative: work on the new site has already begun and Makor Chaim must move out as soon as possible.

The New Historic Site in the Heart of Gush Etzion

During the search for the three boys, government officials began to understand the school's unique role in Israeli society, recognized the long standing need for a permanent campus and rushed to approve a new site in the heart of Gush Etzion in the valley between Neve Daniel, Elazar & Alon Shyut.



The campus is located on the biblical "Derech Ha'Avot" named after Abraham, Isaac & Jacob - where Elazar HaMaccabi fell in battle and where until this day one can see the ancient Roman milestones and Second Temple period ritual baths.

We were privileged to be part of the historic return to Kfar Etzion and now we face the new challenge of the historic return to the ancient "Patriarchs Way".

The new campus will embody our unique spirit and will maintain the rustic atmosphere of our current Kibbutz location.

The materials to be used will be made of the basic elements of water, wood, stone, iron and light.

The campus buildings will be harmoniously integrated into the green spaces which will provide shaded study areas. The campus design is rooted in the Judean topography, blending into the local landscape. The interrelationship between the inner spaces and the outer ones will all be representative of the integration of the disparate parts which characterize our unique organization.







With commitments from government sources for about 65% of the high school compound, about 35% of the dormitory as well as some private commitments for the Bet Midrash - we are in the middle of the construction, but we must have more support from the private sector if we are to succeed!
